DOCUMENT/ID ASSISTANCE

We are one of KC's largest providers of document & ID assistance. Make an appointment for help getting a copy of your birth certificate, photo ID, or work permit.



RENT & UTILITIES ASSISTANCE

Limited KCMO water funds provided on first come, first served basis, usually on the 1st business day of the month. Additional rent & utilities assistance is available as funding allows.



KC MEDICINE CABINET

Qualified clients may be eligible for vouchers to help pay for prescriptions, medical supplies, vision care, and dentistry needs. A Photo ID, Social Security Card, recent proof of address (within 30 days), and proof of income are required.
